Dos when writing your personal statement

Do use your best English and don't let spelling and grammatical errors spoil your statement. Do show that you know your strengths and can outline your ideas clearly. Do be enthusiastic – if you show your interest in the course, it may help you get a place. Do expect to produce several drafts of your personal statement before being totally happy with it. Do ask people you trust for their feedback.

Don'ts when writing your personal statement

Don't exaggerate – if you do you may get caught out at interview when asked to elaborate on an interesting achievement.

Don't rely on a spellchecker as it will not pick up everything – proofread as many times as possible.

Don't leave it to the last minute - your statement will seem rushed and important information could be left out.
